- The consent form **MUST** be completed and returned to your Success Coach by **June 1, 2017**. Any consent form not received by June 1, 2017 may cause your space to be forfeited.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Camp Overview- **The High School summer camp is for rising 9th graders through 12th graders.**

- All summer camps are FREE to TRiO students.
- Only TRiO students can participate in summer camps.
- TRiO summer camps are optional but HIGHLY encouraged.
- Student must attend both days of camp.
- Any student who does not show for their approved camp without notifying TRiO will be recommended for suspension from future TRiO activities.
- Respect and following all camp rules is expected of all camp participants.
- Rising 9th graders must have been promoted to high school to attend the high school camp.

Transportation

- Students are to remain with TRiO Coaches during the entire camp timeframe.
- Students are responsible for their own travel to camp site.
 - Students are to arrive at their camp site between 8:00-8:30 am.
 - Students are to be picked up between 2:30-3:00 pm.

Food

- TRiO will provide lunch and light snacks daily.
- Students should eat breakfast prior to drop-off.
- Students are welcome to bring snacks.
- Students are encouraged to bring money for extra spending on Thursdays while we are traveling.

Dress

- Dress comfortably and appropriately for the weather.
