Shelby Police Officer Danielle Brown graduated from Cleveland Community College with a Basic Law Enforcement Training Certificate and says this is “not the first time she has felt led to protect and serve.” Brown has also been a member of the Army National Guard since 2006 and served one tour in Iraq from 2009-2010.

After returning home from overseas, Brown says there were many people who went above and beyond to help her begin her education and that “CCC Financial Aid Associate Sherry Cranor, went above the call of duty to help me obtain VA Benefits so that I could afford to further my education.”
