

Applying for a Health Sciences Program

If I want to apply to a health sciences program I must:

- Apply to CCC online using one of the following program codes: **Associate Degree Nursing (A10300A)**, **Radiography (A10300X)**, **Practical Nursing (A10300PN)**, **Medical Assisting (A10300MA)**, **Surgical Technology (A10300S)**, **Surgical Technology Advanced*** [*applicants must have a diploma in Surgical Technology and be working in the field (A10300SA)*].
- Submit TEAS score by January 25 to Audrea Brown. See TEAS testing information on the back of this card.
- Submit official high school transcript or equivalent to the Student Enrollment Center by January 25.
- Submit official college transcripts if you wish to receive transfer credit from another college(s) to the Student Enrollment Center by January 25. Associate Degree Nursing and PN to ADN applicants must submit official copies of ALL college transcripts.



- Have a college or unweighted high school GPA of 2.0. Associate Degree Nursing and PN to ADN applicants must have a college or unweighted high school GPA of 2.5.
- Complete or be exempt from all developmental courses: ENG 002 grade of P2 & MAT 003 grade of P2. Students must have either already completed/exempted or currently be enrolled in developmental coursework by January 25.
- *Unsure which program is right for you?* Forums will be held in July and November to give potential applicants more information about each health sciences program.

ATI Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS)

- Required for all applicants
- Assesses preparedness to enter health science fields
- Must complete testing on all four sections (reading, math including Algebra, science and English) in one sitting
- Scores available immediately upon completion
- Additional attempts must be at least 30 days apart (cannot exceed 3 times in a calendar year for ADN applicants)
- For multiple attempts, the highest score will be accepted
- Testing must have occurred within the last five years as of the application deadline
- Official test transcript of scores must be sent by official testing facilities directly to Audrea Brown (meeting all criteria above) by January 25
- Copies of transcripts from applicants will not be accepted
- Testing can be completed at CCC
- Estimated cost is \$77.00
